The Clayton Local Development Corporation is planning to apply to New York State for the 2022 Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI) and the NY Forward program for the Village of Clayton. These New York State funding programs are transforming downtown neighborhoods into vibrant communities where New Yorkers want to live, work and raise families.

The applications are required to describe potential transformative projects that could use DRI/NYF funding within the next 2-3 years. A successful application will highlight a variety of projects of all sizes that advance the community's vision for revitalization and regional needs.

The purpose of this Request for Proposals (RFP) is to provide the opportunity for all interested parties to propose projects advance the community's vision for downtown revitalization. The CLDC Grant Committee will review all project proposals and nominate projects to include in the DRI/NYF application. Projects will be reviewed based on the funding criteria. A variety of projects will be selected from the RFP responses with the goal of demonstrating a broad range of possibilities and strategies for downtown revitalization.

Eligible projects must be located in or have an impact on the proposed DRI and/or NY Forward area (please see attached map).

There is no guarantee that projects submitted in response to this RFP will be included in the final DRI/NYF application. Projects that are included in the application are meant to demonstrate the potential impact that a large public investment could create in the Clayton downtown area. Projects included in the application must directly support the community's vision. If selected for a DRI/NYF award, the community will be required to form a Local Planning Committee made up of local stakeholders. That Committee will complete a Strategic Investment Plan with the assistance of a team of expert planners funded through the project. The Strategic Investment Plan will identify which projects will ultimately be funded.

Downtown Revitalization Initiative and NY Forward Goals:

The CLDC Grant Committee seeks to identify a combination of public and private projects to include in the application so that all goals are addressed. Proposed projects should meet at least one of the following goals.

DRI and NY Forward Program Goals

- Creation of an active, desirable downtown with a strong sense of place
- Attraction of new businesses that create a robust mix of shopping, dining, entertainment, recreation, and service options for residents and visitors, and that provide job opportunities for a variety of skills and salaries.
- Enhancement of public spaces for art and cultural events that serve existing members or the community but also draw in attendees from around the region
- Building a diverse population with residents and workers supported by complementary diverse housing and employment opportunities
- Growing the local tax base
- Providing amenities that support and enhance downtown living and quality of life
- Reducing greenhouse gas emissions by creating compact, walkable development
 patterns that increase public transit ridership and allow for adoption of district-wide
 decarbonized heating and cooling; and by supporting efficiency and electrification of
 buildings, installation of onsite renewable energy generation and electric vehicle
 charging.


